• Life Membership criteria.

To assist the preparation of Life Membership submissions, the Board has formulated a set of criteria that they believe any application should be judged on. These can be found on the SARA web site here.

• New firearm storage requirements.

As many of our members will be aware, there are new requirements for gun safes. For those who had safes with walls only 1.6mm thick (the new thickness is 2mm for inside the house and 3mm if in a shed etc) but complying in all other details, you can apply to have your safe approved as a "prescribed safe". The police have issued an information brochure on this subject entitled "PRESCRIBED FIREARMS SAFES FOR EXISTING LICENSEES". The Statutory Declaration referred to can be found here.
