Frequently Asked Questions

When is shooting conducted?

Most clubs conduct a regular shoot on Saturday afternoons.

What are the licence requirements?

A firearms licence is not initially required to participate using a club rifle or another licenced members rifle. "Club Use" for your licence can only be attained once you become a member.

What equipment is required?

A centrefire target rifle fitted with a scope plus some ancillary equipment. There are limitations on the weight and calibre of the rifle.

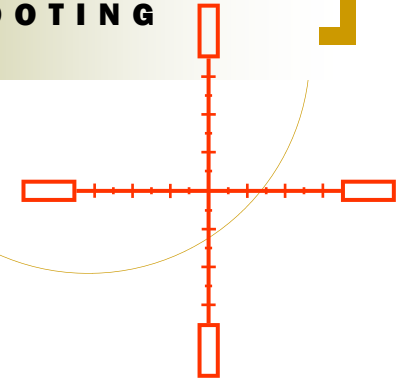

F-CLASS TARGET SHOOTING

F-Class is a long distance target shooting discipline conducted over ranges from 300m to 1000m.

Suitable for people of all ages and abilities, members can compete on a personal, club, state and national level. Regular attendance is not vital for this sport.

F-Class is ideal for those that want to learn about ballistics and the effect of wind, distance and temperature on bullet trajectory.

Members shoot from the prone position (lying down) using front and rear rests to support the rifle.

F-Class consists of two categories determined by restrictions on rifle calibre and equipment, F-Class Standard and F-Class Open.

Strict safety protocols are employed at all shooting ranges and members are required to adhere to directions from the relevant range officer at all times.
