Rifle Shooting - the Sport

A Rifle Range is a place where you enjoy the skill of using a target rifle, specified by the NRAA, in order to achieve an optimum score of 50 out of 50. This may sound easy, however the ranges span from 300m to 900m where you must tackle the weather elements such as light, wind and rain. Classes: Target Rifle - Open Peep sights, F class - Telescope and stand.



Who can participate

Rifle shooting is a sport where men and women compete as equals. The earliest an individual can take up the sport is 14 years of age, while the club has members aged into their seventies still actively shooting.

Strong emphasis on safety

The club commands firearms discipline and safety, with rules having a strong emphasis at all times. There is a qualified Range Officer in charge at all activities and Nationally Accredited Coaches available to assist shooters.
