



PHOENIX TARGET RIFLE CLUB

Phoenix Target Rifle Club was formed by the amalgamation of two clubs that used to shoot on the Dean Rifle Range at Port Adelaide. The two clubs were Adelaide Rifle Club (over 100 years old) and Port Adelaide Rifle Club. These two clubs joined together in 2002 shortly before we were shifted from Port Adelaide to Lower Light Rifle Range (40 km north of Adelaide).

The Lower Light range is the State Headquarters Range for South Australia and is where the annual State Championships (SA Queen's) are held.

Our club shoots full-bore target shooting over ranges extending from 300m to 900m and provision is made at Lower Light for Match Rifle to shoot back to 1100m.

We currently have around 20 members and on Saturdays we have club competitions. Shooting takes place from 1pm to 4:30 pm and visitors are welcome. Equipment can be provided for those interested in trying this sport out. Everyone from 14 years old upwards can join up and learn skills of self discipline, mastery of fine motor skills and development of self worth and character.

For those with a love of technology there is no greater challenge than to understand what is necessary to maintain a rifle in top condition and to be able to use it intelligently.

There are a number of Full-Bore Rifle Clubs in South Australia and there are Open Prize Meetings held during the year at various towns which members from all over the State attend to compete against one another in A, B and C Grades.

For those who prefer to use a telescopic sight a class has been created (F Class) to enable competition. This form is growing stronger each year.
